

Anti-Bias Behavior

Verbal statements and behaviors that directly challenge bias, prejudice and stereotyping in whatever form they may take.

Examples

- Verbally challenging biased or prejudiced statements or behaviors.
- Offering a written challenge to biased or prejudiced statements or behaviors.
- Participating in a roundtable discussion on topics related to bias.
- Ensuring that organizational policies and practices are free from bias.
- Discussing why common stereotypes are wrong or inaccurate.
- Participating in educational programs designed to reduce bias.
- Rewarding others for actively working to reduce bias.
